Our Prayers Need to Be...

Psalm 143:1-2 (ESV)- Hear my prayer, O Lord; give ear to my pleas <u>for mercy</u>! In your faithfulness answer me, in your righteousness! Enter not into judgment with <u>your servant</u>, for <u>no one living is</u> <u>righteous</u> before you.

2. HONEST

Psalm 143:3-4 (ESV)-For the enemy has pursued my soul; he has crushed my life to the ground; he has made me sit in darkness like those long dead. Therefore my spirit faints within me; my heart within me is appalled.

3. HUNGRY

For his presence

Psalm 143:6 (ESV)- I stretch out my hands to you; <u>my soul thirsts for</u> <u>you</u> like a parched land. Selah

For his voice

Psalm 143:7 (ESV)-<u>Answer me quickly</u>, O Lord! My spirit fails! Hide not your face from me, lest I be like those who go down to the pit. Let <u>me hear</u> in the morning of your steadfast love

4. HOPEFUL

For direction, For protection, restoration

Psalm 143:8-12 (ESV)-Let me hear in the morning of your steadfast love, <u>for in you I trust</u>. <u>Make me know the way</u> I should go, for to you I lift up my soul. Deliver me from my enemies, O Lord! I have fled to you for refuge. Teach me to do your will, for you are my God! Let your good <u>Spirit lead me</u> on level ground! For your name's sake, O Lord, preserve my life! In your righteousness bring my soul out of trouble! And in <u>your steadfast love you will</u> cut off my enemies, and <u>you will</u> <u>destroy</u> all the adversaries of my soul, for I am your servant.
