## **Guidelines For Worship Service**

- ✦ High risk people are encouraged to worship from home.
- ✤ There are sidewalk markings to assist with social distancing.
- ✦ The Church doors will open at 10:20am for check in.
- ✦ A masked staff member will greet you at the door.
- ✦ Hand sanitizer and masks are available at the door.
- ✦ Temperatures will be checked at the door (non invasive, non contact).
- ◆ Masks will be worn into the building and until seated.
- ◆ We will have one service starting promptly at 10:45am.
- ◆ Doors will be locked at 11:00am.
- ✦ There will be no greeters, greeting time, or passing the offering plate.
- ◆ Please sit where the blue tape is (marked for proper spacing).
- ◆ Please refrain from leaving your seat unless absolutely necessary.
- ✦ Masks should be worn when not in your seat.
- ✤ Dismissal will be by rows.
- ♦ An offering donation box is located at the Welcome Desk.
- No midweek activities or Sunday school classes at this time.

## According to the CDC the definition of a high risk person is:

65 or older, especially those with chronic lung disease; moderate to severe asthma; chronic heart disease; severe obesity; diabetes; chronic kidney disease undergoing dialysis; liver disease; or weakened immune system.

Please don't attend church if you have any of these symptoms or have been in close contact with anyone that has been diagnosed with COVID19.

Cough	Shortness of breath or difficulty breathing
Chills	Fever greater than 100.0 degrees
Repeated shaking with chills	Muscle pain
Headache	Sore Throat
Loss of taste or smell	Diarrhea
